Company Background:

Salesforce provides enterprise cloud computing solutions. The company offers customer relationship management technology that brings companies and customers together. Its customer 360 platform helps the group deliver a single source of truth, connecting customer data across systems, apps, and devices to help companies sell, service, market, and conduct commerce. It also offers Service Cloud for customer support, Marketing Cloud for digital marketing campaigns, Commerce Cloud as an e-commerce engine, the Salesforce Platform, which allows enterprises to build applications, and other solutions, such as MuleSoft for data integration.

Industry Outlook:

CRM software continues to compound at a high-single to low-double-digit CAGR through 2030, driven by Al-enabled automation, data integration, and the ongoing shift from on-premise to cloud. Salesforce leads with ~21% share and the deepest partner ecosystem.

Investment Thesis:

Durable compounder benefiting from: (1) AI-first product cycle (Einstein 1 / Agentforce) embedded across clouds; (2) expanding multi-cloud adoption and data moats (Data Cloud); (3) international expansion toward >40% of revenue by FY30; (4) disciplined capital allocation and margin expansion (FCF and EBIT)

Investment Risks:

- Macro IT-spend softness elongating deal cycles and renewals.
- Intensifying competition (Microsoft, Oracle, Adobe) and AI-native entrants.
- Data-privacy/cyber risks from a large third-party ecosystem (partners/AppExchange).
- Execution risk on AI monetization timing and pricing (Agentforce, Data Cloud).
